

GUIDELINES FOR GIRL OPPORTUNITY FUND

Based on need and availability of funds, financial assistance is awarded to registered Girl Scouts who wish to participate in special program events. A special program event would be any council-sponsored program or activity (including summer camp), and GSUSA-sponsored national or international opportunities. Leaders should let parents know this assistance is available, but should encourage each girl to save or earn as much as she can of the event fee. To be considered for financial assistance, fill out the application and send to *Girl Scouts of Northwest Florida*. Submission of form does *not* guarantee approval of funds.
